Days 1 - 2

Arrival & Orientation

Fly into Valencia Airport where you'll be met on arrival by a member of the local Projects Abroad team. They'll take you to meet your host family, where you'll stay for the next two weeks (typically staying with at least one other participant of the same gender).

Settle in and get to know the city from the local people themselves. Enjoy an authentic home-cooked meal and get some rest before your internship begins!

Day 2 begins meeting fellow interns before your orientation. Get to know the local staff, the basics of the city, and what to expect during your medical internship.

After lunch you'll visit the Virtual Hospital, where you'll tour the cutting-edge medical training facilities. This is followed by a tour of Valencia itself and a welcome dinner of traditional tapas with your new dedicated teen medical intern crew.



Day 3 - 6

Week One

Your days now take on a familiar pattern, with mornings spent in the virtual hospital, followed by lunch and a transfer to the second hospital where you'll spend time doing direct patient observation and medical shadowing.

Your routine will quickly become established but the exposure you receive will continue to be dynamic, giving you equal opportunity to explore a wide-range of specialisms both virtually and through observing real-world medical work.

Your evenings will include Spanish lessons on Tuesday and Thursday, with a paella cooking class on Wednesday. Friday evening will feature a city centre walking tour, the ideal way to relax, unwind, and reflect with your fellow interns on your successful first week.


Day 7

Day trip to Xàtiva

Take a one hour train journey outside of Valencia to explore the historic hill top town of Xàtiva.

It's rich in history, culture, and scenic views with a medieval castle and charming "old town" streets just waiting to be explored.

From the Romans, Moors, and the Borgia's, it's a layered town with lots of stories to tell.



Day 8

Explore Valencia

Spend your morning at the City of Arts & Sciences, one of the "12 treasures of Spain", featured in a variety of well-known film, music videos, and television series, including Star Wars.

After lunch, enjoy a sunny afternoon unwinding on the beach. Picnic to the sound of the waves, swim, and relax. Saving your energy for later in the day... After three hours on the beach, join a challenging scavenger hunt exploring famous markets and landmarks around Valencia.



Days 9 - 13

Week Two

You'll continue to rotate across departments and specialisms as you go back to dividing your time between the virtual hospital and direct patient observation.

Rejoin your Spanish lessons on Monday, with your fourth and final on Thursday afternoon—followed by a Flamenco Show. Your fluency in Spanish culture is reaching new heights!

On Tuesday, you'll visit the Museo Valenciano de Etnología too, where you will learn about both the “tangible and intangible” heritage linked to the traditional and popular culture of Valencia.

On Wednesday, visit the Museo de la Cerámica featuring the largest collection of ceramics in Spain, including pieces by Pablo Picasso. On Friday, you'll finish your internship at lunchtime with an afternoon spent at the Turia Gardens, before buying souvenirs and enjoying an evening meal with your new medical friends.

Departure

Reflect on the once-in-a-lifetime journey you've undertaken as you head back to the airport. Don't forget to share your contact details with your new friends to forever remember your time in Valencia.
